# How to play Freebet Blackjack & 22 SIDE BET

It doesn't matter how much you wager, the dealer will match your exact bet and pay for you to double and split.

If you lose then you only lose one bet. If you win then you are paid the full amount.

The dealer will even bet for you more than once during a hand if needed.

For example:

The player is dealt  and the dealer has a  showing

The dealer will pay for the player to split 

If the player receives another 3 then the dealer will also pay for the split. If the player receives, say, a 7 on one of the 3s then the dealer will also pay for that double.



So, in the above example, the player is risking just one bet as the dealer has placed three further wagers for the player.

However, if the player wins all of the bets then they receive the full payment of four bets.

Blackjack pays 3 to 2.

All splitting and double after splitting allowed.

Freebet doubling on two card hand totals 9, 10 and 11.

Freebet splitting on all Pairs except 10s and face cards.

Dealer will push on a total of 22, however Blackjacks will still get paid.

Players also have the option to place a wager on the 22 betting area. The bet will win if the dealer's final total is 22. The player's 22 wager will remain active until the dealer's hand is completed even if the player's main Blackjack wager is no longer in play. Higher odds are paid if the 22 is the same colour or the same suit:

Mixed Colour 22:	10 to 1
Same Colour 22:	17 to 1
Same Suit 22:	35 to 1

## House Edge

Freebet:	0.73%
22 Side Bet:	5.85%
